

**Course Name:** Mobile Dispatch Computer System

**Course Summary:**

This two (2) hour introductory course that will cover the basic Mobile Dispatch Computer (MDC) system and Tiburon software. The various functions/tasks that can be performed on the MDC will be reviewed. Students will have an opportunity to log-on to the system and perform a variety of tasks through a hands-on learning experience.

**Performance Objectives**

1. Demonstrate knowledge of the general uses of an MDC.
2. Demonstrate knowledge of the purpose for Tiburon software.
3. Use an MDC by starting one, logging on, and identify the log in process with Sheriff's dispatch.
4. Demonstrate knowledge of four main uses for an MDC by Probation Department Officers.
5. Demonstrate knowledge of the emergency button or buttons for contacted Sheriff's dispatch on an MDC.
