4th Quarter Range Pistol Qualification 2019

Equipment:

Duty weapon (Glock 17/19), 3 magazines, 12 rounds in each magazine for a total of 36 rounds.

Purpose:

To establish the necessary skills required of an officer to effectively shoot from the standing position, kneeling position, moving backwards off the “X” and shoot under a time constraint.

Objective:

For the officer to demonstrate the skills of marksmanship and tactical skills of shooting from the standing, kneeling and with movement.

Standard:

To successfully complete this course, the officer will be required to demonstrate safe gun handling skills, demonstrate proper loading and re-loading and hit a minimum of 29 rounds within the target.

Disqualifiers:

Less than 80% hit rate (minimum 29 rounds on target) and any safety violations.

Qualification:

-10 yard line; officers will load and make ready; upon the threat command, officers will have 15 secs to fire 5 rounds (standing), 5 rounds (kneeling) and 2 rounds to the head (standing)

-7 yard line; officers will load and make ready; upon the threat command, officers will have 10 secs to fire 5 rounds (standing), 5 rounds (kneeling) and 2 rounds to the head (standing)

-5 yard line; upon the threat command, officers will “EXIT” in the indicated direction (left or right) and fire 2 rounds to the chest and 2 rounds to the head. Repeat 4x for a total of 12 rounds.

Additional:

Officers will be given a demonstration of all different kneeling positions they can choose from. HT communication will also be discussed. Specifically, when running an individual that comes back UTL. Officers should be asking dispatch for or providing identifiers on the subject (SMT'S) Cold weather attire will also be discussed.
